

## JEWISH CULTURE IN BARCELONA

Visitors can get a unique insight into Barcelona's rich Jewish heritage on Sunday 4th. To celebrate the European Day of Jewish Culture, the city council has organised a series of events like a dramatized tour through the Call, the city's Jewish quarter, for families with children at 5pm, a concert of Sephardic music at 7.30 and many activities based around this year's pan-European theme of Jewish cooking, such as "sweet and salty tales" by Catherine Favret at midday, a kosher appetizer served at the town hall at 1.15pm, stalls selling typical Jewish cakes and titbits throughout the day at Carrer Sant Domènec del Call and, in the same street, a book, arts and crafts and food market from 11am to 10pm. Admission to the MNAC museum is free till 2.30pm.
